Charismatic – having unusually strong personal allure or appeal; marked by charisma

Brave - ready to face pain or danger; courageous

Flexible - able to change or meet new situations

Adventurous - willing to take risks in order to find excitement; daring

Easy-going – not worried or rushed; not easily upset; relaxed; calm; placid; not demanding or strict; lenient

Creative - able to make or do something new or with imagination

Assertive - forward or aggressive in speech or action

Optimistic - likely to be hopeful that things will work out well

Wise - having understanding and good judgment about what is true or good

Stable - fixed, firm, or steady in position; not shaky or easily moved

Zealous - characterized by, showing, or filled with an intense enthusiasm, as toward a cause, purpose, or activity

Spiritual – of, having to do with, or made up of spirit, rather than the physical body or world; of or having to do with a church or religion
